
AN ACT for the better protection of deer in the Counties of Androscoggin and Kennebec.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Whoever in any manner or at any time 2 within five years of the approval of this act shall hunt, 3 chase, catch, kill or destroy any deer within the counties 4 of Androscoggin and Kennebec forfeits forty dollars for 5 each deer so hunted, chased killed or destroyed.

- SECT. 2. All the provisions of chapter thirty of the 2 Revised Statutes and all amendments thereto relating to 3 deer not inconsistent with this act are hereby made a part 4 of this act.
 - SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
