STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section eight of chapter eleven of the
Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and
sixty-eight of the Public Laws of 1889.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section eight of chapter eleven of the Revised Statutes,
2 as amended by chapter two hundred and sixty-eight of
3 the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, is
4 hereby amended by adding to said section the following:
5 'Provided, however, that any parent or guardian of any
6 pupil in the public schools may, at his own expense, pro-
7 cure for the separate and exclusive use of such pupil the
8 text books required to be used in such schools,' so that
9 said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

‘Section 8. Towns shall provide school books for the
11 use of the pupils in the public schools, at the expense of
12 said town ; and all money raised and appropriated for that
13 purpose, shall be assessed like other moneys. Provided,
14 however, that any parent or guardian of any pupil in the
15 public schools may, at his own expense, procure for the
16 separate and exclusive use of such pupil the text books
18 required to be used in such schools.’
