STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Calais Academy.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500)
2 be and is hereby appropriated annually for two years to
3 aid Calais academy.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Previous to 1893 Calais Academy had not received any aid from the state, although most of the other academies had. The reason for this was that the trustees had quite a sum of money well invested. The demands from outside pupils increased to such an extent that it became absolutely necessary to about double the capacity of our building, in doing this we about used up our fund and it will be impossible to maintain this academy in its present state of efficiency without this aid. The academy is doing most excellent work, and is forty-four miles distant from any other.
