RESOLVE in favor of the town of Chesterville for rebate of
State Tax.

Resolved, That the state treasurer be directed to refund
2 to the town of Chesterville the sum of two hundred ninety-
3 one dollars and eighty-eight cents (\$291.88) on account of
4 error in the state tax for the years 1893 and 1894.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This is to certify that we have this day examined the assessors books for the town of Chesterville and taxes assessed thereon for the year 1892.

It appears that the assessors returned to this board an amount in excess of correct sum \$46,073 which we included in our valuation for that town for that year. The State taxes for years 1893 and 1894 upon this excess amount would be as follows, to wit:
