## STATE OF MAINE.

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE

AN ACT to authorize licensed Taxidermists to receive and have in possession Fish and Game or parts thereof for the purpose of mounting the same.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The commissioners of inland fisheries and 2 game may, upon application, issue a license to such per-3 sons as taxidermists, who, in their judgment, are skilled 4 in that art, of good reputation and friendly to the fish and 5 game laws of this state. For such license the applicant 6 shall pay into the state treasury the sum of five dollars to 7 be credited as additional to the funds appropriated by the

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8 state to inland fisheries and game, and be in force for three 9 years from the date of its issue, unless sooner revoked. 10 Such licensee may at all times have in his possession at 11 his place of business fish and game or parts thereof law-12 fully caught or killed in open time for the sole purpose of 13 preparing for, and mounting the same; and such fish and 14 game or parts thereof may be transported to such licensee 15 and retained by him for the purposes aforesaid, under such 16 rules, restrictions and limitations as shall from time to 17 time be made by said commissioners and stated in such 18 original license and additions made thereto from time to 19 time by said commissioners.

SECT. 2. Such licenses may be revoked by said commis-2 sioners at any time after notice and an opportunity for a hear-3 ing; and every licensee and carrier violating any of the 4 provisions of this act, or of the rules, restrictions or limita-5 tions set out in said license and additions thereto, shall, on 6 complaint before any trial justice or municipal or police 7 court, be fined not less than twenty nor more than fifty 8 dollars.

SECT. 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 act are hereby repealed.
