STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section 31 of chapter 3 of the Revised
Statutes of 1883, as amended by chapter 186 of the Public
Laws of 1893, relating to changing Ward Limits in cities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 31 of chapter 3 of the Revised
2 Statutes of 1883, as amended by chapter 186 of the Pub-
3 lic Laws of 1893, is hereby amended by striking out the
4 words "registered voters of such city," in third line, and
5 inserting in lieu thereof the words 'votes cast,' so that
6 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 31. No change made by the city council, in
8 the limits of any city ward, shall be valid unless it is
9 approved by a majority of the legal votes cast, at the

10 election of city officers, held next after such action of said
11 council; and warrants for such ward meetings shall con-
12 tain an article for that purpose.'
