STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section 31 of chapter 3 of the Revised Statutes of 1883, as amended by chapter 186 of the Public Laws of 1893, relating to changing Ward Limits in cities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 31 of chapter 3 of the Revised 2 Statutes of 1883, as amended by chapter 186 of the Pub-3 lic Laws of 1893, is hereby amended by striking out the 4 words "registered voters of such city," in third line, and 5 inserting in lieu thereof the words "votes cast," so that 6 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 31. No change made by the city council, in 8 the limits of any city ward, shall be valid unless it is 9 approved by a majority of the legal votes cast, at the 10 election of city officers, held next after such action of said 11 council; and warrants for such ward meetings shall con-12 tain an article for that purpose.'
