### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED

AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Ellsworth Street Railway Company, and to authorize its Construction across Navigable Tide Waters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the 2 Ellsworth Street Railway Company which were granted 3 by chapter three hundred and ninety-one of the Private 4 and Special Laws for the year eighteen hundred and 5 eighty-nine, as extended and enlarged by chapter five 6 hundred fifteen of the Private and Special Laws for the 7 year eighteen hundred and ninety-three, are hereby

8 extended for two years additional; and the persons named 9 in said acts, their associates and successors, shall have all 10 the rights, powers and privileges that were granted them 11 by said acts, to be exercised in the same manner, and for 12 the same purposes as specified in said acts.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
