STATE OF MAINE.

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.**

AN ACT relating to the Rumford Falls and Rangeley Lakes
Railroad Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The railroad locations of the Rumford Falls
2 and Rangeley Lakes Railroad Company from Rumford Falls,
3 in Rumford, through Rumford, Mexico, Roxbury and
4 Byron, all in the county of Oxford and State of Maine, as
5 now on file in the office of the county commissioners for the
6 said county of Oxford, are hereby ratified, approved and
7 confirmed, as legal and valid.

SECT. 2. The assignment to the Rumford Falls and
2 Rangeley Lakes Railroad Company, its successors and
3 assigns, by the Portland and Rumford Falls Railway of
4 its right, title and franchise under the existing statutes of
5 the State of Maine, to locate, build and operate a railroad
6 from the abutment now located by the Rumford Falls and
7 Rangeley Lakes Railroad Company on the northerly bank
8 of the Androscoggin river, at Rumford Falls, in the county
9 of Oxford and State of Maine, through the towns of
10 Rumford, Mexico, Roxbury and Byron, to a point on
11 Mooselucmaguntic lake, near Benis stream, in the town of
12 Rangeley, county of Franklin and State of Maine, is
13 hereby ratified, approved and confirmed, as legal and
14 valid.

SECT. 3. The time within which the Portland and Rum-
2 ford Falls Railway Company, or its assignee, the Rumford
3 Falls and Rangeley Lakes Railroad Company may locate,
4 build and construct a line of railroad from Rumford Falls
5 to Rangeley lakes is extended to four years from the
6 approval of this act.

SECT. 4. The Rumford Falls and Rangeley Lakes Rail-
2 road Company is authorized to locate, build, maintain and
3 operate branch railroads of standard guage, for logging
4 purposes, from points of connection with its main line as
5 follows: from a point or points in Roxbury or Byron, in
6 the said county of Oxford, westerly through Andover or
7 Andover North Surplus, to Andover West Surplus; from
8 a point or points on said main line in said Byron,

9 westerly in township Letter D; also from a point or 10 points on the main line in said Byron, easterly to or 11 through township Letter E.

SECT. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
