STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize Horace Purinton, his associates, heirs
and assigns to build and maintain a wharf in the Kennebec
river in the city of Augusta.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Horace Purinton, his associates, heirs and
2 assigns are hereby authorized and empowered to extend,
3 construct and maintain a wharf to the deep channel in the
4 waters of the Kennebec river on his shore front in the city
5 of Augusta.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
