STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and twenty-three of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three, relating to Accident or Casualty Insurance Companies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter two hundred and twenty-three of the Public 2 Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three is hereby 3 amended by striking out the word "sixty," in the seventh 4 and ninth lines thereof and inserting the word 'thirty,' so 5 that said act as amended shall read as follows: 'No con-6 ditions, stipulations, or agreements contained in any appli-7 cation for insurance in any foreign or domestic casualty or 8 accident insurance company, or contained in any policy 9 issued by any such company, or in any way made by any

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10 such company, limiting the time within which notice of 11 the accident or injury, or death, shall be given to such 12 company, to a period of less than thirty days after the 13 happening of the accident or injury, or death, shall be 14 valid. Said notice may be given to the company insuring, 15 at any time within thirty days after the happening of the 16 accident or injury, or death, and shall be valid and bind-17 ing on the company.'
