IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT relating to Larceny of Beasts and Birds.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Whoever without the consent of the owner and with a
2 felonious intent, takes any beast or bird ordinarily kept in
3 a state of confinement and not the subject of larceny at
4 common law, shall be deemed guilty of larceny.
