STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to protect the Alewives fisheries on the Sheepscot River.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. That there shall not be any alewives taken 2 from the Sheepscot river or its tributaries except Back 3 river so called, for the term of three years from the pas-4 sage of this act under a penalty of one dollar for every 5 alewive taken.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
