STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize the building of a Fish Weir at Harbor
Island in the County of Hancock.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION. 1. Charles E. Sprague, his associates and
2 assigns, are hereby authorized to build and maintain a fish
3 weir on the eastern side of Harbor Island, in the county of
4 Hancock, and to extend the same twelve hundred feet into
5 tide waters.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
