STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT additional to Section twenty one of Chapter forty-
one of the Revised Statutes regulating sales of lumber.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

In any action hereafter brought for the price of boards,
2 plank, timber, joists, shingles, clapboards, staves or hoops,
3 unless sold by the cargo, any failure to survey, measure,
4 view or cull and brand the same and to give certificate
5 thereof as required by section twenty-one of chapter forty-
6 one of the Revised Statutes shall not defeat recovery in
7 such action, unless it appears that before delivery the pur-
8 chaser requested such survey, measurement, view or cull-
9 ing, and branding and certificate.
