
## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT additional to Section twenty one of Chapter fortyone of the Revised Statutes regulating sales of lumber.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

In any action hereafter brought for the price of boards, 2 plank, timber, joists, shingles, clapboards, staves or hoops, 3 unless sold by the cargo, any failure to survey, measure, 4 view or cull and brand the same and to give certificate 5 thereof as required by section twenty-one of chapter forty-6 one of the Revised Statutes shall not defeat recovery in 7 such action, unless it appears that before delivery the pur-8 chaser requested such survey, measurement, view or cull-9 ing, and branding and certificate.
