### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to incorporate the town of Woodville.

## Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Township No. 2 Indian purchase in the 2 county of Penobscot, and known as Woodville plantation, 3 is hereby incorporated into a town by the name of Wood-4 ville; and the inhabitants of said town are hereby vested 5 with all the powers, privileges, immunities and liabilities 6 of other towns.

SECT. 2. Any justice of the peace within the county of 2 Penobscot is hereby empowered to issue his warrant to 3 some inhabitant of said town directing him to notify the 4 inhabitants thereof to meet at such time and place as he

- 5 shall appoint, to choose such officers as other towns are 6 empowered to choose at their annual town meetings.
- SECT. 3. The town hereby created shall take the effects 2 belonging to Woodville plantation and shall also assume all 3 the obligations of said plantation.
  - SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
