**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.**

AN ACT entitled "An Act to regulate the taking of Salmon
and Shad in Orange river, Whiting, Washington County."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

All persons shall be allowed to take any salmon, shad
2 or alewives in the waters of Orange river in the town of
3 Whiting, in the county of Washington, up to one hundred
4 and thirty yards of the fish way at the lower dam in said
5 river, subject, however, to all the laws of the state, and
6 laws regulating the taking of such fish in said river.
