STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT entitled "An Act to regulate the taking of Salmon and Shad in Orange river, Whiting, Washington County."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

All persons shall be allowed to take any salmon, shad 2 or alewives in the waters of Orange river in the town of 3 Whiting, in the county of Washington, up to one hundred 4 and thirty yards of the fish way at the lower dam in said 5 river, subject, however, to all the laws of the state, and 6 laws regulating the taking of such fish in said river.
