RESOLVE in favor of the town of Stockton Springs.

Resolved, That there be paid by the treasurer of state to
2 the town of Stockton Springs out of the school funds of
3 the current year, the sum of eighty-five dollars and forty
4 cents, due said town on account of its proportion of school
5 funds for the school year eighteen hundred and ninety-three.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

After the apportionment of school money was made for the year 1893 to the town of Stockton Springs, it was found that the number of scholars returned was 283. The true number that should have been returned was 318.

The state superintendent of schools, Mr. Stetson, says: "The records of this office indicate that a mistake has evidently been made in the school return of Stockton Springs for the year 1893, and that the claim made is a just one, and the town should be reimbursed to the amount of \$85.40."
