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## STATE OF MAINE.

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**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-FIVE.**

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AN ACT to amend paragraph 8 of section 6 of chapter 6  
of the Revised Statutes, relating to Poll Taxes.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Paragraph 8 section 6 of chapter 6 of the Revised  
2 Statutes is hereby amended by adding after the word  
3 “charges” in the last line the words, ‘and the polls of all  
4 soldiers and sailors who receive state pension,’ so that said  
5 paragraph shall read as follows :

‘VIII. The polls and estates of persons who by reason  
7 of age, infirmity and poverty, are in the judgment of the  
8 assessors unable to contribute toward the public charges ;  
9 and the polls of all soldiers and sailors who receive state  
10 pension.’
