AN ACT to amend paragraph 8 of section 6 of chapter 6 of the Revised Statutes, relating to Poll Taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Paragraph 8 section 6 of chapter 6 of the Revised

- 2 Statutes is hereby amended by adding after the word
- 3 "charges" in the last line the words, 'and the polls of all
- 4 soldiers and sailors who receive state pension,' so that said
- 5 paragraph shall read as follows:

'VIII. The polls and estates of persons who by reason

7 of age, infirmity and poverty, are in the judgment of the

- 8 assessors unable to contribute toward the public charges;
- 9 and the polls of all soldiers and sailors who receive state
- 10 pension.'
