STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to Prevent the use of narrow tires in the towns of
Brunswick and Topsham.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. No person or corporation shall transport
2 any load, goods or thing in any vehicle on wheels drawn by
3 more than one animal over any portion of Main street in
4 the town of Brunswick between the railroad crossing and
5 Androscoggin bridge unless the rims and tires of the wheels
6 of such vehicles shall be at least five inches wide, if such
7 persons or corporations shall have been previously forbid-
8 den so to do by the selectmen of said town.

SECT. 2. Any person or corporation violating the pro-
2 visions of the foregoing section shall pay a fine of five dol-

3 lars for each offense to be imposed on complaint and to be
4 paid into the treasury of said town.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
