AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 291 of the Private and Special Laws of 1891, entitled "An Act for the protection of fish in B pond in Upton, in Oxford county."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter 291 of the Private and Special Laws of 1891 is 2 hereby amended so that said chapter as amended shall 3 read as follows:

'Chapter 291. It shall be unlawful to take any trout 5 from the waters of "B" pond, in the town of Upton, 6 Oxford county, except as hereinafter provided. Any per-7 son may take trout in said waters with a rod, single line 8 and artificial flies, and in no other manner during the same

9 time that it is now lawful to take trout in Richardson lake 10 in said county. Provided, also, that the inland fish and 11 game commissioners may take trout therefrom for breed-12 ing purposes.

Any person violating the provisions of this act shall be 14 punished by a fine not exceeding thirty dollars, or by 15 imprisonment not exceeding thirty days and one dollar for 16 every trout taken in violation of this act.'
