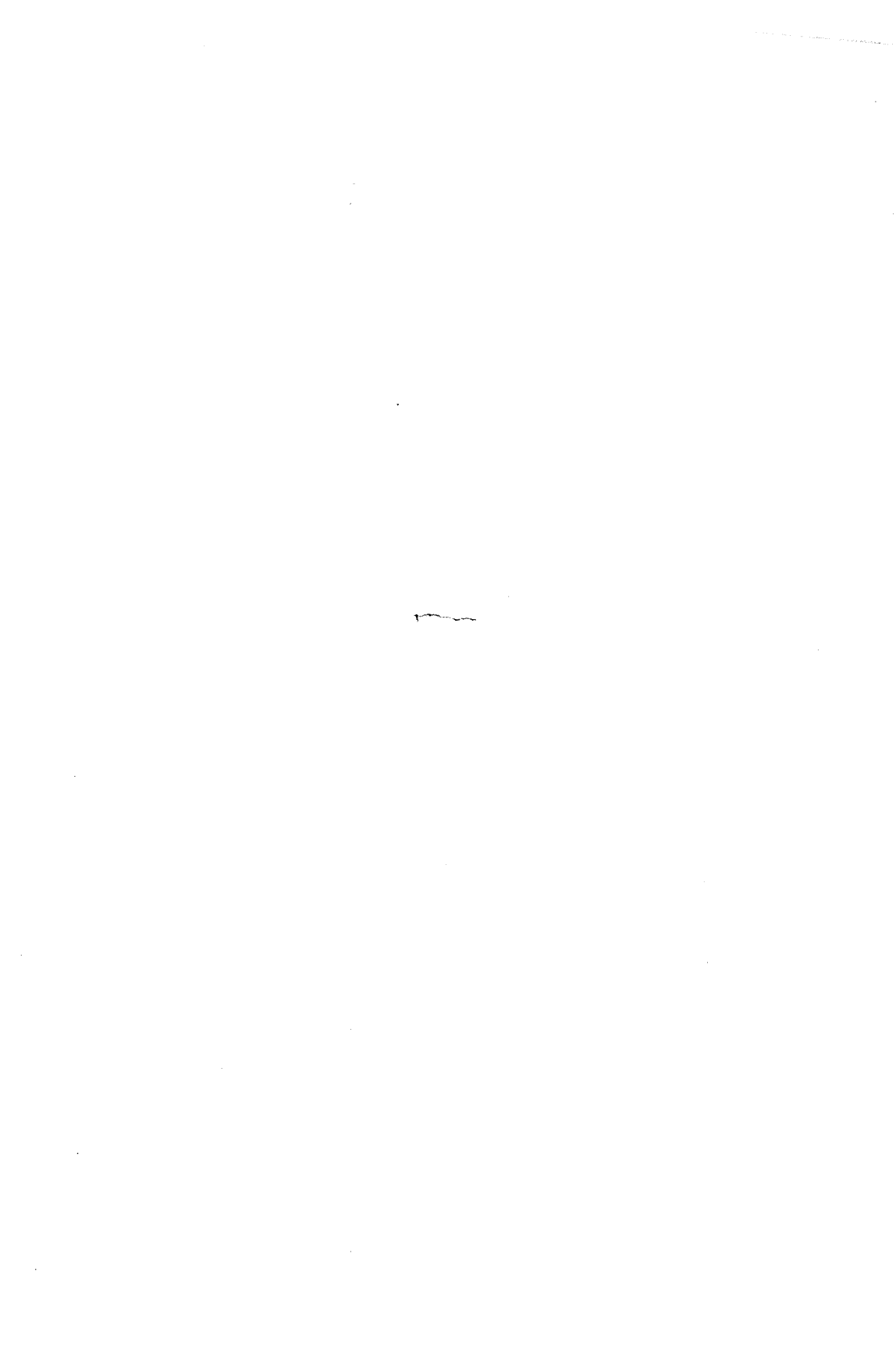
AN ACT to amend Section 20 of Chapter 30 of the Revised
Statutes, as amended by Chapter 48 of the Public Laws of
1891, relating to the killing of muskrats.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 20 of chapter 30 of the Revised
2 Statutes as amended by chapter 48 of the Public Laws of
3 1891, is hereby amended by adding to said section 20 the
4 following words: 'This section shall not apply to Lily
5 pond situated in the towns of Rockport and Camden, and
6 it shall be lawful to kill muskrats in said pond during all
7 seasons of the year,' so that said section as amended shall
8 read:

‘Section 20. Whoever, between the first day of May 10 and the fifteenth day of October, destroyes any mink, 11 beaver, sable, otter, fisher, or whoever destroys any 12 muskrat between the twentieth day of May and the first 13 day of March, forfeits ten dollars for each animal so 14 destroyed, to be recovered on complaint.’ This section 15 shall not apply to Lily pond situated in the towns of 16 Rockport and Camden, and it shall be lawful to kill musk- 17 rats in said pond during all seasons of the year.’

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
