STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Portland and Yarmouth Electric Railway Company, and enable it to cross navigable tide waters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

All the provisions of chapter four hundred seventy-seven 2 of the private and special laws of 1893 relating to the 3 incorporation of the Portland and Yarmouth Electric Rail-4 way Company and all the limitations therein contained, 5 are hereby extended for and during the period of two 6 years additional thereto, and the persons named in said 7 act, their successors and assigns, shall have all the rights,

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8 powers and privileges that were granted them by said act 9 to be exercised in the same manner and for the same pur-10 poses as provided in this act. Said corporation shall be 11 liable for any damages to water and gas pipes caused by 12 the action of the electric current used by it. .
