RESOLVE in favor of Maine Industrial School for Girls.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropriated
2 from the funds in the state treasury, the sum of seven
3 thousand dollars for the use of the Maine Industrial School
4 for Girls at Hallowell, to meet the current expenses for the
5 year one thousand, eight hundred and ninety-five, and
6 seven thousand dollars to meet the current expenses for
7 the year one thousand, eight hundred and ninety-six.
