AN ACT to make valid the organization of the Durham Agricultural Society and to authorize said society to receive the annual stipend allowed by law to agricultural societies.

 $B\epsilon$ it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The organization of the Durham Agricultural Society of 2 Androscoggin county is hereby declared legal and valid 3 and said society shall be entitled to receive its share of the 4 annual stipend allowed by law to agricultural societies, 5 subject to the conditions imposed by the laws of the state.
