STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Madawaska Training School.

Resolved, That the sum of two (2) thousand dollars for
2 the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five be appropriated,
3 for the purpose of enlarging the school lot, completing the
4 school buildings of Madawaska training school at Fort
5 Kent, and furnishing a supply of water for the same, said
6 sum to be expended under the direction of the trustees of
7 state normal schools.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The appropriation called for in the accompanying resolve is for the following purposes :

1. To furnish the hall in the main building.
2. To finish and furnish the model school room and paint the same.
3. To finish stable and for water supply.
