STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT entitled "An Act relating to Gaslight Companies."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

All gaslight companies in this state which are authorized 2 to furnish gas for lighting are hereby further authorized to 3 furnish gas for heating and for power and proper appliances 4 therefor under the same conditions and with the same rights 5 as they are now authorized to furnish gas for lighting purfoses.
