STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT relating to the hunting or killing of deer in Androscoggin and Kennebec counties.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall in any manner hunt, kill 2 or destroy any deer in the counties of Androscoggin and 3 Kennebec for the term of five years, under a penalty of 4 one hundred dollars for every deer so hunted, killed or 5 destroyed.
