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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend Section one of Chapter thirty of the  
Revised Statutes relating to Mischievous Dogs.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section one of chapter thirty of the Revised Statutes is  
2 hereby amended by striking out the word "double" in the  
3 fifth line so that said section as amended shall read as  
4 follows :

‘Section 1. Towns may pass by-laws to regulate the  
6 going at large of dogs therein. When a dog does damage  
7 to a person or his property, his owner or keeper and also  
8 the parent, guardian, master, or mistress, of any minor  
9 or servant, who owns or keeps such dog, forfeits to the

10 person injured, the amount of the damage done; to be  
11 recovered by action of trespass.
