## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend Section one of Chapter thirty of the Revised Statutes relating to Mischievous Dogs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one of chapter thirty of the Revised Statutes is 2 hereby amended by striking out the word "double" in the 3 fifth line so that said section as amended shall read as 4 follows:

'Section 1. Towns may pass by-laws to regulate the 6 going at large of dogs therein. When a dog does damage 7 to a person or his property, his owner or keeper and also 8 the parent, guardian, master, or mistress, of any minor 9 or servant, who owns or keeps such dog, forfeits to the

10 person injured, the amount of the damage done; to be 11 recovered by action of trespass.
