STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to give the town of Castine power to transfer in part one or more of its schools to the Eastern State Normal School.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The legal voters of the town of Castine in 2 the county of Hancock, may, by a majority vote, at any 3 legally called meeting, authorize its school committee to 4 make arrangements with the principal of Eastern State 5 Normal School by which students of the said Normal 6 school may teach in one or more of the schools of said 7 town, under charge of the teachers employed by said town.

SECT. 2. The said schools shall be, as now, under the 2 control of said town of Castine.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
