IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Bath Street Railway.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The Bath Street Railway is authorized to
2 extend its lines and to construct, build and maintain a
3 street railroad to be operated by animal power or elec-
4 tricity, over such streets, roads, highways and bridges,
5 and tide waters in the towns of Brunswick, Topsham and
6 Lisbon as shall from time to time be fixed and determined
7 by the municipal officers of said towns, subject to all the
8 restrictions, obligations and liabilities of its existing char-
9 ter, with amendments thereto, heretofore or hereafter
10 made, and with all the rights, powers and privileges
11 therein contained.

SECT. 2. The consent, in writing, of the Brunswick
2 Electric Railroad Company must first be obtained before
3 rights in the town of Brunswick can be used beyond those
4 at present vesting in the Bath Street Railroad as given by
5 Laws of 1893, chapter 636.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
