STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to prevent the Adulteration of Candy.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. No person shall by himself, his servant, or 2 agent of any other person or corporation manufacture for 3 sale or knowingly sell or offer to sell any candy adulterated 4 by the admixture of terra alba, barytes, talc, or any other 5 mineral or metallic substance or by poisonous colors or flav-6 ors or containing brandy, whiskey, rum, wine or any alco-7 holic liquor in liquid form or other ingredients deleterious 8 or detrimental to health.

SECT. 2. No person shall by himself, his servant, or 2 agent of any other person or corporation offer for sale any

3 candy under the name of brandy, whiskey, rum or wine 4 drops.

SECT. 3. Whoever violates any of the provisions of 2 this act shall be punished by a fine not exceeding one hun-3 dred dollars (\$100.00) nor less than fifty dollars. The 4 candy so adulterated shall be forfeited and destroyed under 5 the direction of the court.

SECT. 4. It is hereby made the duty of the prosecuting 2 attorneys of this state to appear for the people and to attend 3 to the prosecution of all complaints under this act, in all 4 the courts in their respective counties.
