STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE,

AN ACT to amend Chapter 623 of the Private and Special
Laws of 1893, entitled "An Act to authorize the town of
Athens in Somerset County, to expend a portion of its
school money in Somerset Academy."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 623 of the Private
2 and Special Laws of 1893 is hereby amended so that said
3 section as amended shall read as follows:

‘Section 1. The town of Athens by its superintending
5 school committee is hereby authorized to send to school in
6 Somerset Academy in said town, such scholars as in the
7 opinion of said committee, are sufficiently advanced in
8 their studies to attend a grammar or high school, not

9 exceeding sixty scholars except by the consent of the
10 trustees of said academy that reside or may hereafter
11 reside within the limits of said town for which they may
12 expend from the common school funds of said town, a
13 sum not exceeding that which the scholars so instructed
14 would be entitled to draw upon a pro rata division of
15 said funds among the whole number attending school in
16 said town.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
