STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to prohibit fishing with seines or set nets in the Sasanoa river, below Bath, from the first day of October till the first day of April following.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The use of seines or set nets in the Sasanoa 2 river, below Bath, from the first day of October until the 3 first day of April following, is hereby prohibited under 4 penalty of ten dollars (\$10) for each offense.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
