IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-FIVE.

---

AN ACT to prohibit fishing with seines or set nets in the  
Sasanoa river, below Bath, from the first day of October  
till the first day of April following.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The use of seines or set nets in the Sasanoa  
2 river, below Bath, from the first day of October until the  
3 first day of April following, is hereby prohibited under  
4 penalty of ten dollars (\$10) for each offense.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
