STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to restore certain territory to South Paris
Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. So much of the territory set off from the 2 South Paris Village Corporation, by act of the Legislature 3 approved February 6, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, 4 as is described in said act as the estate of Richard Lom-5 bard, is hereby restored to, and made a part of said South 6 Paris Village Corporation.

SECT. 2. Said terrritory, with all residents thereon, 2 shall become by this act a constituent part of said South 3 Paris Village Corporation, subject to all the present

4 and future liabilities of said corporation the same as if 5 said set-off had never been made.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved by 2 the Governor.
