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**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-FIVE.**

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AN ACT to amend Chapter 652 of the Private and Special  
Laws of 1893, relating to Fishing in Great Embden Pond  
in Somerset County.

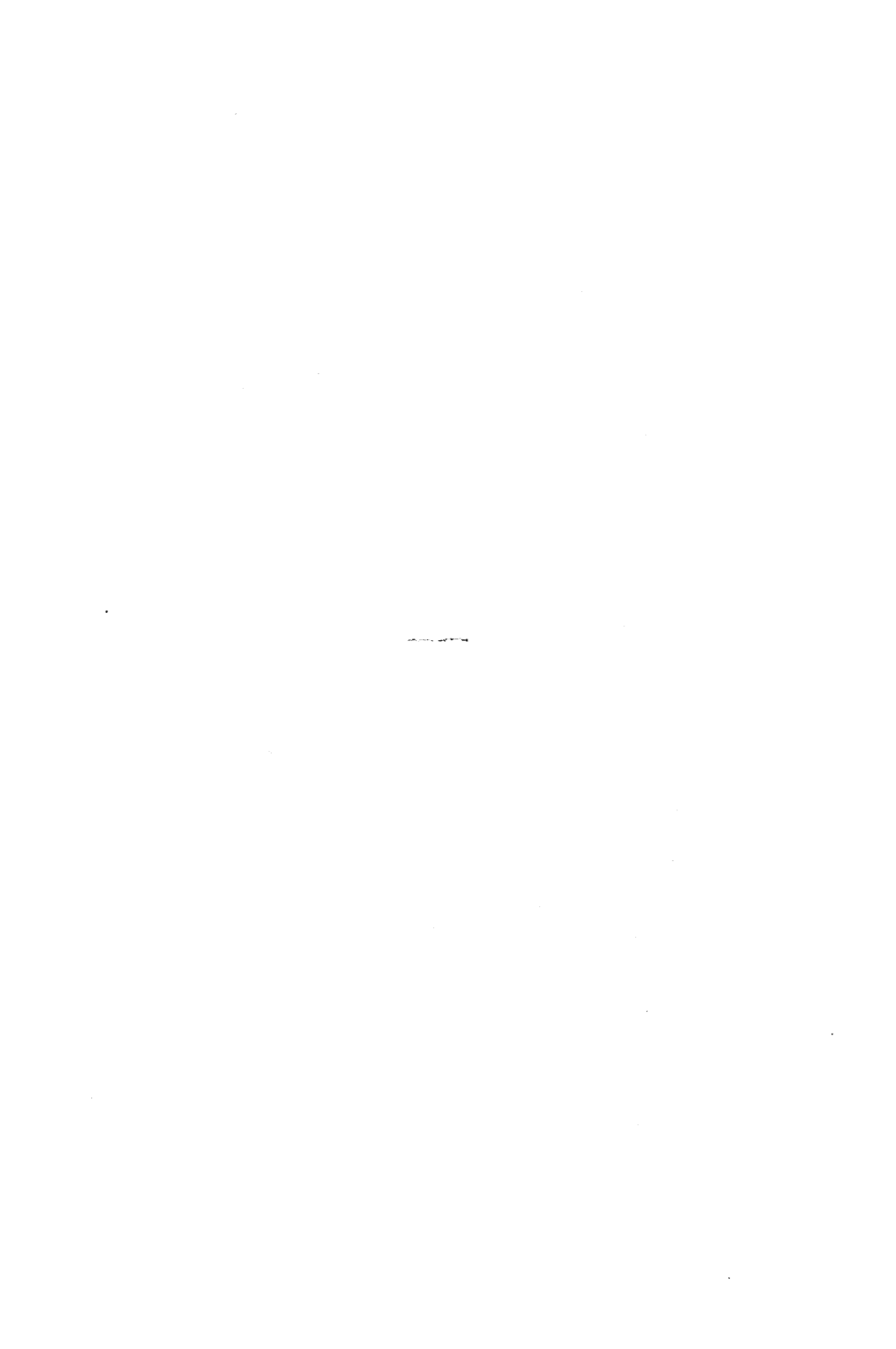
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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section one of chapter 652 of the Private Laws of 1893  
2 is hereby amended as follows:

By striking out in lines two and three, the words  
4 "Great Embden pond in Somerset county, or." Also by  
5 striking out in the fourth line the words "said pond," and  
6 the word "five," and inserting in place thereof the words,  
7 'Great Embden pond in Somerset county,' and the word  
8 'six,' so that said section as amended shall read as fol-  
9 lows:

‘Section 1. No person shall take, catch, kill or fish for  
11 in any manner, any trout or land-locked salmon in any of  
12 the streams of water emptying into Great Embden pond  
13 in Somerset county for a period of six years from the first  
14 day of April, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred  
15 and ninety-three.’
