STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to fix the salaries of the Judge and Register of
Probate for Waldo County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION. 1. From and after the first day of January, in
2 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nine-
3 ty-five, the salary of the judge of probate for the county
4 of Waldo shall be three hundred and fifty dollars per year
5 instead of the sum now fixed by law.

SECT. 2. From and after the first day of January in
2 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
3 ninety-five, the salary of the register of probate for the
4 county of Waldo shall be five hundred dollars per year
5 instead of the sum now fixed by law.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
