RESOLVE in favor of the Director of the Maine Agricultural Experiment Station.

Resolved, The state treasurer is hereby authorized 2 and directed to pay to the director of the Maine Agricult-3 ural Experiment Station, the sum of three hundred and 4 ninety-eight dollars and seventy-four cents, the same being 5 to re-imburse him for the expense, over and above the 6 receipts for analysis fees, of licensing and inspecting, as 7 required by law, the commercial fertilizers sold in the 8 state. ·
