STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of town of Trescott in County of
Washington.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred and fifty (\$250)
2 dollars be and hereby is appropriated annually for two
3 years to be expended on roads and bridges under the direc-
4 tion of the county commissioners.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The town of Trescott in Washington county situated on the stage line between Lubec and Machias has thirty-seven miles of road to build and five long bridges to keep in repair with a total valuation of only \$49,849 and a debt of \$4,275 and a rate of taxation of forty-one mills on the dollar they ask for this small appropriation to relieve the excessive taxation that her people are subjected to.
