**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.**

AN ACT in relation to the Penobscot Shore Line Railroad
Bonds held by the City of Bath.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The City of Bath is hereby authorized and
2 empowered to guarantee the payment of the Penobscot
3 Shore Line Railroad registered bonds, now held by said
4 city in its sinking fund, as they may be sold to meet the
5 maturing obligations of the city, issued in aid of the con-
6 struction of the Knox and Lincoln Railroad.

SECT. 2. This act to take effect when approved.
