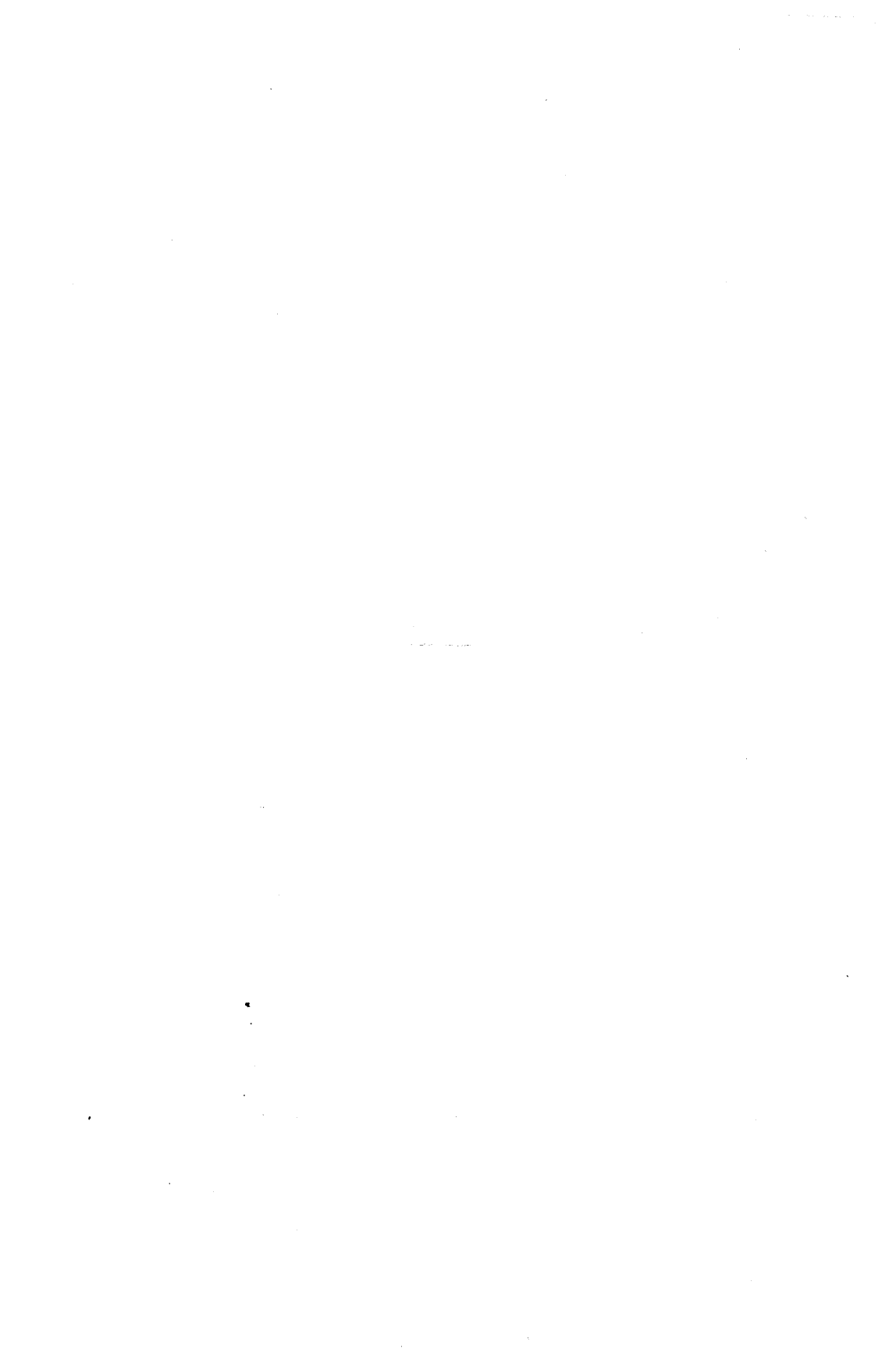
AN ACT for the better Protection of Deer in the county of
Sagadahoc.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Whoever in any manner or at any time
2 within four years of the approval of this act shall hunt,
3 chase, catch, kill or destroy any deer within the county of
4 Sagadahoc forfeits forty dollars for each deer so hunted,
5 chased, killed or destroyed.

SECT. 2. All the provisions of chapter thirty of the
2 Revised Statutes relating to deer, not inconsistent with
3 this act are hereby made a part of this act.
