AN ACT to extend the Rights, Powers and Privileges of the Cumberland Illuminating Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the 2 Cumberland Illuminating Company which were granted by

3 chapter 143 of the Private and Special Laws of the year

4 1887 are hereby extended for two years additional, and all

5 the rights, powers and privileges that were granted by said

6 act may and shall be exercised in the same manner and for

7 the same purposes as provided in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
