## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT for the protection of trout in Newell and Dyer brooks in the town of Durham.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. No person shall, in any manner, take or 2 catch any trout from the Newell and Dyer brooks or their 3 tributaries in the said town of Durham, for the term of four 4 years after the passage of this act.

SECT. 2. Any person violating section one of this act, 2 shall be liable to a fine of five dollars, and a further penalty 3 of one dollar for each trout so taken, to be recovered on 4 complaint before any trial justice in the county of Andros-5 coggin, one-half to the complainant and one-half to the 6 town of Durham.
