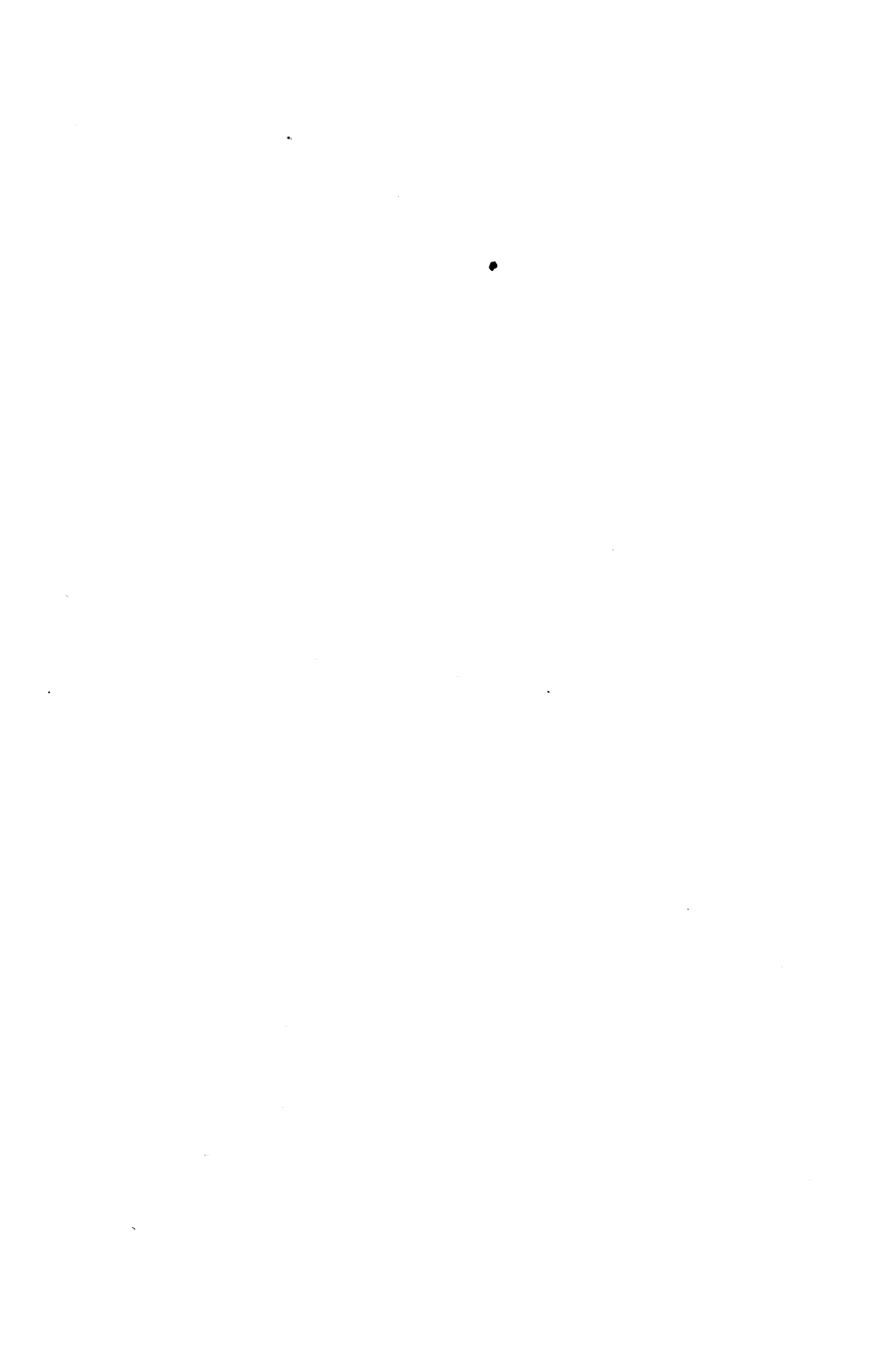
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT for the protection of trout in Newell and Dyer
brooks in the town of Durham.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. No person shall, in any manner, take or
2 catch any trout from the Newell and Dyer brooks or their
3 tributaries in the said town of Durham, for the term of four
4 years after the passage of this act.

SECT. 2. Any person violating section one of this act,
2 shall be liable to a fine of five dollars, and a further penalty
3 of one dollar for each trout so taken, to be recovered on
4 complaint before any trial justice in the county of Andros-
5 coggin, one-half to the complainant and one-half to the
6 town of Durham.
