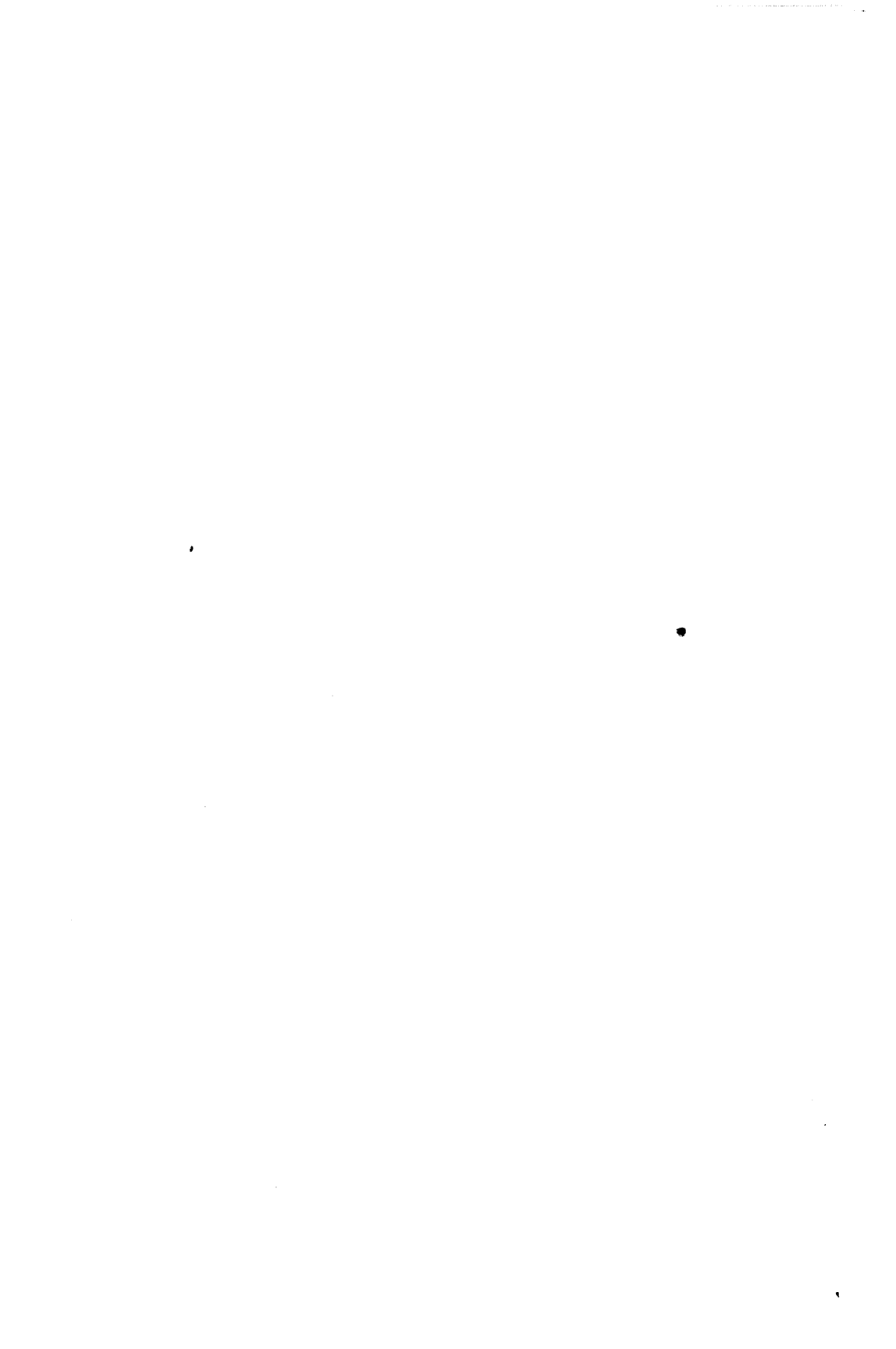
AN ACT for the better protection of fish in Long Pond,
Mt. Desert Island.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from
2 fishing for, or taking trout, land-locked salmon or smelts
3 from Long pond in the towns of Tremont and Mount
4 Desert in the county of Hancock, from the first day of Octo-
5 ber in each year, to the first day of May following for a
6 period of four years.

SECT. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions
2 of this act shall be punished by a fine of five dollars for

3 each offense and a further penalty of one dollar for each
4 fish taken, to be recovered on complaint before any trial
5 justice in said county one-half to the complainant and one-
6 half to the said county of Hancock.
